## CURRICULUM INFORMATION Autumn 2017

**Class 2 Miss H. Leake**

### ENGLISH

#### Grammar, Punctuation and Spelling

- Capital letters – for names, people and places.
- Full stops, exclamation and question marks.
- Adjectives and expanded noun phrases.
- Past and present tense.

#### Writing

- Simple sentences including punctuation and use of adjectives.
- Command, exclamation, question and statement sentences.
- Sequencing and writing stories.

#### Phonics

- The children will have daily phonic sessions continuing from Class 1.

### MATHS

#### Place Value

- Counting and ordering numbers to 100 and beyond.
- Reading and writing numbers up to 20 in words.
- Understanding the value of tens and ones.

#### Addition & Subtraction

- Addition and subtraction with numbers up to 20.

#### Multiplication & Division

- Counting in different ways such as in 1's, 2's, 3s, 5's and 10's.

#### Geometry

- Identifying and sorting 2D and 3D shapes.

#### Fractions

- Quarters, halves, thirds, two quarter and three quarters.

### SCIENCE

#### Everyday Materials

- Identifying everyday materials and what they are used for.
- Looking at objects made from more than one material.
- Investigating materials suitability.
- Seasons: Autumn and Winter
- Describing weather in Autumn and Winter.
- How animals adapt in Autumn and Winter.

### RELIGIOUS EDUCATION

#### Belonging

- Belonging through Christianity.
- Looking at bible stories.
- Belonging to a church community.

#### Christmas

- Sharing the good news of Jesus' birth.
- Events surrounding the birth of Jesus.

### COMPUTING

- Using colours and brushes on a computer programme.
