### HOW TO USE THIS GRID

Over this half term, 'pick and mix' 6 activities from the boxes below. You need to choose at least one English and one Maths activity, the rest are up to you. You can complete the activities whenever you want over the half term so long as you have done at least 6 by the end of the half term.

When you have completed one of the tasks, bring in a photo or record of the task, to display on the Home Learning wall. You could earn house points for home learning too!

#### Literacy (L)

In the Nativity, the wise men followed a star. Go into your garden with a grown up and see what stars and constellations you can see. Write a short report or few sentences about what you spotted...

Go to the local library to find some wintery themed books. Which is your favourite and why?



Write a wintery poem or make up a rhyme with your grown up. Decorate it with wintery pictures too!

#### Maths (M)

Draw a picture of a snowman using as many 2D shapes as you can! Can you name all of the shapes you used?

Do some festive baking using your measuring skills....mince pies, shortbread, Christmas cake or something else. Don't forget to take a photo of you having fun!



Have a look on a thermometer, to track the temperature each day. What is the temperature on the coldest day you can record?

#### Communication and Language (CL)

Talk about how we can stay safe on Bonfire Night and take a picture of you putting these safety skills into action.

Talk about seasonal changes you can see around you. How are the trees and nature changing now the weather is colder?

#### Personal, Social, Emotional Development (PSED)

Learn about an alternative Winter celebration which is different to your own. This might be Christmas from another country or a celebration belonging to another faith entirely! Bring in some facts to share with the class...

#### Physical Development (PD)

Learn how to properly wrap up present or gift for someone special and then have a go yourselves!

Use some frozen ice cubes to create your own igloo or build an ice building for your toys to live in! Work quickly before they melt...

#### Understanding the World (UW)

Create a 'frost catcher' using a twig. Twirl it into frosty spider's webs in your garden and look at the patterns it creates. Talk about where frost comes from.



Pack a suitcase of things you would take to a snowy place! Think carefully about the things you would put inside.

#### Expressive Art and Design (EAD)

Create a firework picture using black paper, chalks, paints or glitter!

Decorate a Christmas Bauble using a repeating pattern. You can use marker pens, glitter glue, sequins or whatever else you wish.
