HOW TO USE THIS GRID

Over this half term, **choose 6 activities** from the boxes below. You need to choose at least one English and one Maths activity, the rest are up to you.

You can complete the activities whenever you want over the half term so long as you have done at least 6 by the end of the half term.

When you have completed one of the tasks, bring it into school to display on the Home Learning wall. You could earn house points for home learning too!

WEEKLY HOME LEARNING

On **Tuesdays**, you will receive a set of spellings to learn and a piece of English or Maths to do.

Your piece of homework is due in and your spellings will be tested on the following **Monday**, which means you have a whole week and a weekend to do it.

DAILY READING AND TIMES TABLES

Read every day at home, with an adult. Discuss what you have read and record your reading in the diary. Remember to explore any new vocabulary you come across too.

Practise your number bonds to 10 too, just a few minutes a day to learn them by heart.

ENGLISH

- Write about or draw and label a picture of something you did during the summer holidays.
- Go to phonicsplay.co.uk and practice your phase 2 and 3 phonics using the free games.
- Go on an a-z object hunt around your home and draw a picture to show which object you found for each letter.

MATHS

- Write your numbers 1- 20 in numerals and draw some pictures to represent these. E.g. Write the number 2 and draw 2 buttons.
- Practise your number bonds to 10 and 20.
- Practise counting in 2s, 5s and 10s.

SCIENCE

- Design an outfit of what you could wear in a hot and cold country. Label the materials that you would use.

RELIGIOUS EDUCATION

- Write a prayer based on our value of thankfulness.

COMPUTING

- Research your favourite animal using the computer and write some interesting facts down.

HUMANITIES (History/Geography)

- Use a map or an atlas to find 2 or more hot and cold countries

ART / DESIGN

- Create an animal that you might find in the artic.

PHYSICAL EDUCATION

- Practise your catching and throwing skills at home.

MUSIC

- Go on a sound hunt and write down what you found.

PSHE&C (Personal, social, health education, and citizenship)
