HOW TO USE THIS GRID

Over this half term, **choose 4 activities** from the boxes below. You need to choose at least one English and one Maths activity, the rest are up to you. You can complete the activities whenever you want over the half term so long as you have done at least 5 by the end of the half term.

When you have completed one of the tasks, bring it into school to display on the Home Learning wall. You could earn house points for home learning too!

WEEKLY HOME LEARNING

On **Tuesdays**, you will receive a set of spellings to learn and a piece of English or Maths to do. Your piece of homework is due in and your spellings will be tested on the following **Monday**, which means you have a whole week and a weekend to do it.

DAILY READING AND TIMES TABLES

Read every day at home, with an adult. Discuss what you have read and record your reading in the diary. Remember to explore any new vocabulary you come across too. Practise telling the time too, just a few minutes a day.

ENGLISH

- Write a short recount to tell me about something you did over the Easter holidays.
- Write a sentence using each of the different coordinating (and/but/or) and subordinating (because/if/when/that) conjunctions.

MATHS

- Create a tally chart to show either your family's favourite colour, food or sandwich.
- Get a grown up at home to set you some addition and subtraction questions to answer. Remember to use pictures to help you.

SCIENCE

- Name and draw 2 animals in each of the 5 animal groups (mammal, fish, reptile, bird and amphibian).

RELIGIOUS EDUCATION

- Write a prayer based on our new value of perseverance.

COMPUTING

- Use a computer programme (paint) to create a picture of your choice.

HUMANITIES (History/Geography)

- Create a poster about a significant person in history.

ART / DESIGN

- Create a landscape picture of your favourite place.

PHYSICAL EDUCATION

- Create a warm up which can be performed before a PE lesson.

MUSIC

- Make an instrument that can play 3 different notes.

PSHE&C (Personal, social, health education, and citizenship)

- Create a poster to show how you can stay safe in the sunshine.
