HOW TO USE THIS GRID

Over this half term, **choose 6 activities** from the boxes below. You need to choose at least one English and one Maths activity, the rest are up to you.

You can complete the activities whenever you want over the half term so long as you have done at least 6 by the end of the half term.

When you have completed one of the tasks, bring it into school to display on the Home Learning wall. You could earn house points for home learning too!

WEEKLY HOME LEARNING

On **Tuesdays**, you will receive a set of spellings to learn and a piece of English or Maths to do.

Your piece of homework is due in and your spellings will be tested on the following **Monday**, which means you have a whole week and a weekend to do it.

DAILY READING AND TIMES TABLES

Read every day at home, with an adult. Discuss what you have read and record your reading in the diary. Remember to explore any new vocabulary you come across too.

Practise your number bonds to 20 too, just a few minutes a day to learn them by heart.

ENGLISH

- Write 3 facts about a famous explorer.
- Pick a country that you have been to and write 3 sentences to say why someone should go there and explore it.
- Write 5 questions that you would ask a famous explorer. Which famous explorer would you ask?

MATHS

- Write your number bonds to 10 or 20 on a piece of paper.
- Count in 2s, 5s and 10s. Write these down to 20, 50 or 100.
- Follow a cake/ biscuit recipe together with a grown up, take a photo of you measuring out the different ingredients. You could bring a piece in for Miss Leake and Mrs Gemmell to try.

SCIENCE

- Create a poster containing pictures or photos of you wearing clothing suitable for each weather type in Autumn and Winter.

RELIGIOUS EDUCATION

- Write about and draw a picture to show why Christians celebrate Christmas.

COMPUTING

- Walk around town or your local area and take photos of what you see. Can you add a caption to show what the photo is?

HUMANITIES (History/Geography)

- Draw a map of your route to school. What features do you pass? Can you add a key?

ART / DESIGN

- Draw or make something that you would take on a journey if you were an explorer.

PHYSICAL EDUCATION

- Explore a woodland or countryside area and show me how you travelled.

MUSIC

- Make up your own explorer song.

PSHE&C (Personal, social, health education, and citizenship)

- Can you make or draw what you think a healthy lunch or dinner is.
