HOW TO USE THIS GRID

Over this half term, **choose 6 activities** from the boxes below. You need to choose at least one English and one Maths activity, the rest are up to you.

You can complete the activities whenever you want over the half term so long as you have done at least 6 by the end of the half term.

When you have completed one of the tasks, bring it into school to display on the Home Learning wall. You could earn house points for home learning too!

WEEKLY HOME LEARNING

On **Tuesdays**, you will receive a set of spellings to learn and a piece of English or Maths to do.

Your piece of homework is due in and your spellings will be tested on the following **Monday**, which means you have a whole week and a weekend to do it.

DAILY READING AND TIMES TABLES

Read every day at home, with an adult. Discuss what you have read and record your reading in the diary. Remember to explore any new vocabulary you come across too.

Practise your number bonds to 20 too, just a few minutes a day to learn them by heart.

ENGLISH

- Describe the features of a type of transportation and get someone at home to guess it? Get someone to take a photo.
- Write about a journey you have had with your family. Draw some pictures to show what you saw.
- Go on an a-z object hunt around your home and draw a picture to show which object you found for each letter.
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MATHS

- Count how many different coloured cars you see on a journey and write them down.
- Make a 3D model of your favourite transportation.
- Count forwards and backwards to 20 using different voices.

SCIENCE

Create a picture to show what you might see if you looked out of the window of either a car, train, bus or a plane during Autumn and Winter.

RELIGIOUS EDUCATION

Write a prayer about our value of respect.

COMPUTING

Take a photo or find a picture of your favourite transportation and write a sentence to say why you like it.

HUMANITIES (History/Geography)

Find 3 facts about a famous transport inventor.

ART / DESIGN

Design a mode of transport that you would like to travel to school in.

PHYSICAL EDUCATION

Make a dance using the different movements of transportation. Get someone at home to take a photo of you.

MUSIC

Create the sounds of different transportation and show this to your family and Miss Leake.

PSHE&C (Personal, social, health education, and citizenship)

Talk to your family about how you can stay safe when travelling to school.
