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Google Classroom

Dear Parents,

We are going online at St Ippolyts School with **Google Classroom!** This will replace the email system we have been using during lockdown and will enable staff to send out work for your child to complete at home should your child need to isolate from school.



What is google classroom?

Google classroom is an online platform where teachers can upload work, videos, questions and even do online live meetings with their class, all in one place! It can be accessed via the internet on any digital device. The teachers have been busy setting up user-names for your child to access their own google classroom area and you will need these details to login and access the resources. The purpose of our Google Classroom is to provide a safe and secure place to receive and share learning, and a place to connect with school staff and classmates. Parents/carers and pupils are expected to read and adhere to the points outlined below:

- In the event of a lockdown or needing to learn at home, we will check google-classroom daily, to complete all of the latest work set by our teacher. We can submit it on google-classroom and our teacher can give us feedback on our work. Our teacher will also let us know on google classroom when each piece of work is due and we will ensure we submit our work by the set date.
- Sometimes our teacher will ask us to respond to work on google classroom by leaving a comment. These comments and feedback can be seen by other members of class too. Our teachers (including Mrs Peddie) will also be able to see any comments we leave on google classroom. We all have a responsibility to make sure that we are respectful, kind and considerate towards others when leaving comments on our google classroom page and only leave appropriate comments and feedback. We agree to be polite, friendly, and encouraging in any communication with school staff and other pupils at all times.
- We agree to only login using our own username/login and password and to keep our login information private from our friends.
- During google-classroom video meetings, I will ensure I am dressed appropriately and that a grown up from home is present and in the same room as me throughout. I will ensure my behaviour and language is appropriate during these sessions and be respectful and friendly to others.
